



Update on HM4000 float

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Main progress in 2020

- HM4000 prototype upgraded in terms of testing processes and manufacture
- Deep floats for 6000 m (HM6000) under development
- Tentative deployment in the Western Pacific in May 2021

Hardware of the control system



Buoyance drive devices updated



- 10 sets of buoyancy drive devices have been assembled.
- Onshore cycle test and pressure test have been completed.

Assembly and Test



- Assembly of 10 prototypes has been completed.
- 1 prototype has been completed in the lake test.
- 1 prototype is about to be tested in the SCS.

Prototypes of HM4000





- Parking depth: 500 m to 4000 m nominal parking depth 1000 m
- Adjustable ascending/descending speed
- Safety strategy grounding detection emergent ascending for a time-out or an excessive profiling
 - Low-power strategy

Prototypes of HM4000



RBRARGO3 CTD

SEB61 CTD

• There will be 10 HM4000 floats to be deployed, with 9 of them are equipped with RBRARGO3 CTD and only one with SEB61.

Tentative deployment



- Upcoming cruise: the Northwestern Pacific Ocean (probably from 10 May to 20 June)
- 10 deep floats at five locations, with 2 floats at each location

Tentative deployment



- The sea water will be sampled by CTD rosettes of the RV after HM4000 floats are deployed.
- A salinometer on-board to measure the salinity of sea water at certain depths.
